Day 1: Sun, Oct 09 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Mon, Oct 10 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Tue, Oct 11 – LISBON, PORTUGAL – EMBARK MARINA. Arrive Lisbon. Transfer to pier and embark Marina. Depart 7:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Wed, Oct 12 – PORTIMÃO, PORTUGAL. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Situated on the sun-kissed coastline of Algarve, Portimão is a colorful city with a bustling waterfront and a charming city center decorated with parks and plazas. The Museum of Portimão traces the history of human settlement in the area as far back as the Roman and Islamic periods. Enjoy beautiful views and explore hidden caves on a scenic boat trip up the coast and along the Rio Arade. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Thur, Oct 13 – SEVILLE (CÁDIZ), SPAIN. Arrive 8:00 am. Overnight in Port. Spend a fabulous day in Seville visiting the magnificent cathedral, climbing the famed Giralda Tower and strolling through the gorgeous Alcazar and its gardens. See the ceramic-encrusted Plaza de España and stroll through the alleys of Barrio de Santa Cruz. Or explore the Andalusian wine country and Jerez, the home of sherry. Don't miss the charm of Cádiz with its gracious squares, its flower-filled parks on the city bastions and its bustling markets. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Fri, Oct 14 – SEVILLE (CÁDIZ), SPAIN. Depart 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sat, Oct 15 – CASABLANCA, MOROCCO. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Stroll through the narrow streets of the old medina and visit the spice market. Admire the Hassan II Mosque built beside the sea. Or journey inland to Rabat, a fascinating old city of kasbahs, souks and Moroccan tradition. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Sun, Oct 16 – GIBRALTAR, UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Go to the top of the Rock and admire the view across the Mediterranean and up the peninsula into Spain. Feed peanuts to the famed Barbary Apes and visit St. Michael's Cave, a fascinating cavern once lived in by Neolithic peoples and visited by early Romans. See the quaint fishing village along the coast and enjoy the colorful town. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Mon, Oct 17 – CARTAGENA, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. This walled city has always been a major naval port due to its natural harbor and strategic location. Enjoy a hilltop view from Concepción Castle, which served as a fortress for the Carthaginians, Romans and other peoples who once occupied the city. Visit the 1st century B.C. Roman Theater, the remains of the 13th century Cathedral of Santa Maria and the Naval Museum. For modernist architecture, see the City Hall, Grand Hotel and Casino. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Tue, Oct 18 – BARCELONA, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Visit the magnificent Gothic cathedral and the amazing La Sagrada Família, Antoni Gaudí's unfinished masterpiece. Enjoy the lovely Montjuïc Gardens, Gaudí's other fabulous structures, the charming squares of the old Gothic Quarter and the Ramblas, Barcelona's famed downtown promenade. Or visit beautiful Montserrat and its monastery in a breathtaking setting high in the mountains. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Wed, Oct 19 – CRUISING THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Thur, Oct 20 – VALLETTA, MALTA. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Discover the myriad of cultural layers of Malta, from its amazing prehistoric temples at Tarxien to beautiful walled medieval Mdina, nearby Rabat, and Marsaxlokk, a colorful fishing village. Admire the stunning scenery and wander through imposing churches and down the streets of fortified towns where the Knights of St. John once held sway. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Fri, Oct 21 – CRUISING THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sat, Oct 22 – CRUISING THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Sun, Oct 23 – JERUSALEM (ASHDOD), ISRAEL. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 10:00 pm. For Christians, Jews and Muslims, Jerusalem is one of the holiest cities on earth, and it is also one of the oldest. Early Bronze Age tools and writings show that Jerusalem has been settled since the 4th millennium B.C. Marvel at the beauty of the Dome of the Rock and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in the walled Old City of Jerusalem, as you stroll through winding streets where people have lived for centuries. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Mon, Oct 24 – JERUSALEM (HAIFA), ISRAEL. Arrive 6:00 am. Overnight in Port. Visit the land of miracles – Galilee, the Jordan River, the Mount of the Beatitudes and Tabgha. Venture to Nazareth, home of the young Jesus. See the largest hanging gardens in the world at the Bahai Gardens of Haifa. Or visit the Nahalal Moshav, a commune established in 1921 by Jewish immigrants. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Tue, Oct 25 – JERUSALEM (HAIFA) ISRAEL. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Wed, Oct 26 – ALANYA, TURKEY. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Alanya rose to prominence during the Middle Ages under the Seljuks, a tribe from central Asia that built the fortress and protective wall that still dominate the city.

Several other buildings from that time also remain, including the octagonal Red Tower and the Seljuk Shipyard. Thousands of archaeological pieces in the Alanya Museum attest to the city's importance through the ages. But history only touches on Alanya's considerable allure. The city sits on a lovely gulf, backed by the pine-forested Taurus Mountains on Turkey's beautiful Mediterranean coast. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Thur, Oct 27 – RHODES, GREECE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Enjoy a walking tour of the old fortified city and stand in awe of the impressive Grand Master's Palace. See where the Colossus of Rhodes once stood and savor the charm of this remarkable walled town. Or drive along the scenic coast to Lindos. Enjoy the whitewashed little town and climb to the ancient acropolis, its temples and wonderful views. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Fri, Oct 28 – ESPHESUS (KUŞADASI), TURKEY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Meander through the ruins of ancient Ephesus and marvel at the famed Library of Celsus, the huge amphitheater, the marble roads with their chariot marks, the amazing mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or journey to three monumental cities of antiquity – Priene, Miletus and Didyma – renowned for their majestic temples and impressive, beautifully preserved stadiums. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Sat, Oct 29 – ISTANBUL, TURKEY. Arrive 1:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Indulge your eyes and senses in this magnificent city astride two continents. Visit beautiful Topkapı Palace, the awesome Hagia Sophia and the impressive Blue Mosque. Cruise the Bosphorus to see the city and its surroundings from another perspective. Visit one of the many museums or stroll through the spice market and the famous Grand Bazaar. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Sun, Oct 30 – ISTANBUL, TURKEY. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 23: Mon, Oct 31 – KAVALA/PHILIPPI, GREECE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Built on a promontory on the site of ancient Neapolis, Kavala offers fine beaches and numerous historic sites. A Byzantine castle lords over Kavala, and its 16th century aqueduct is still intact. The ruins of nearby Philippi include a Roman forum and a 5th century cathedral. (B, L, D)

Day 24: Tue, Nov 01 – ATHENS, GREECE – DISEMBARK MARINA – HONOLULU. Disembark Marina. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B)
