FOR OUR GUESTS Whether you are a loyal past guest or are considering river cruising with us for the first time, we thank you for entrusting AmaWaterways with your future river cruise plans. Here are some of the measures we are taking to protect our guests on board and ashore:

PRE-CRUISE

• **Online Health Questionnaire:** Prior to boarding, an online health and contact screening questionnaire will be required.

EMBARKATION

- **Temperature Check:** At embarkation, guests' temperatures will be taken with no-contact infrared thermometers. If, for any reason, further testing is required, shoreside medical treatment centers are within close proximity.
- **Sanitized Luggage:** Your luggage handles will be sanitized before delivery to your stateroom.

EXPLORING ASHORE

- **Social-Distance Technology:** Your personal portable Quietvox commentary systems will allow you to hear guides while social distancing.
- **Exploring Ashore:** Shore excursions will be conducted in small groups. Guests must use hand sanitizers when getting on and off our coaches that are thoroughly cleaned each morning. In the event that ships are docked side by side, guests will be required to pass over Sun Decks.

ONBOARD

- **Face Coverings:** Protocols continue to change; however, at this time, guests are required to wear face coverings when moving through public spaces.
- **Cleaning & Disinfecting:** We will have ample hand sanitizers available throughout the ship and their frequent use is required by all guests and crew. Our crew has implemented enhanced cleaning and disinfecting measures throughout the ship.
- **Clean Air:** We use state-of-the-art fan coil air conditioning units; there is no recirculating of air on board our ships.
- **Social Distancing:** There will be limitations to the number of guests allowed to sail with us.
- **Safe Dining:** Safety and social distancing will be enhanced throughout our dining room.
- **Excise & Wellness:** You will still get plenty of fresh air and exercise as our bicycles, fitness mats and equipment will be thoroughly sanitized after each use. Use of the Fitness Room is by appointment with cleaning time between use. Throughout Europe and Asia, we provide a variety of onboard wellness activities led by professionally trained Wellness Hosts. Whenever weather permits, these small-group classes will be held on our spacious open-air Sun Decks.
- **No Visitors On Board:** Non-essential visitors are not permitted on board.

Day 1: Sun, June 12 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Mon, June 13 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Tue, June 14 – ZÜRICH, SWITZERLAND. Welcome to Zürich, the global center for banking and finance. After completing arrival formalities, transfer to the hotel. MARRIOT ZÜRICH or Similar (2 Nights)

Day 4: Wed, June 15 – ZÜRICH. Switzerland's largest city, Zürich, seamlessly blends its historic past with its progressive future – all of which will be on full display during your **city tour**. (B)

Day 5: Thur, June 16 – ZÜRICH – LUCERNE. Check out of your hotel and **transfer to Lucerne**, where you'll enjoy a **scenic lake cruise** before checking into your hotel. HOTEL SCHWEIZERHOF LUCERNE or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 6: Fri, June 17 – LUCERNE. Lucerne's beauty and charm is unrivaled. You'll discover this beauty on a **walking tour**, during which you will stop at the iconic **Lion Monument**, sculpted in memory of the Swiss Guards massacred during the French Revolution. You'll also visit the spectacular **medieval walls and towers**, dating back to the 13th century. (B)

Day 7: Sat, June 18 – LUCERNE – BASEL – EMBARK AMAPRIMA. Check out of your hotel. Go on a highlights tour of Switzerland's third largest city, before continuing to Basel where you'll **board your ship**, the AmaPrima. (B, D)

Day 8: Sun, June 19 – BREISACH, GERMANY. Breisach is your **gateway to several different excursions**, depending on your interests. Step back in time with a visit to the enchanting **Alsatian town of Riquewih**, which **looks almost the same as it did in the 16th century**. On your **walking tour**, admire **historic architecture** as well as famous sights, such as the **Dolder Gate**. Alternatively, you may wish to go to **Freiburg**, founded in 1120 and **home to the Freiburg's Münster**, a Gothic cathedral **said to have "the most beautiful spire on earth."** Those wishing a more **active excursion** can **cycle through the scenic countryside**, or go on a **hike to the Black Forest***, a magical land full of cultural traditions, as well as home to elaborate cuckoo clocks. (B, L, D) *Please Note: Black forest hike is weather dependent and may only operate at certain times of year. Please refer to your final documents for details.

Day 9: Mon, June 20 – STRASBOURG, FRANCE. Strasbourg, the capital city of Alsace, offers **flavors of both France and Germany**. Enjoy a **panoramic tour** past the stunning **Parc de l'Orangerie**, the **European Parliament** and the **Place de la République**. Then walk through its iconic UNESCO World Heritage **"La Petite France"** district, which appears to have been **lifted straight from the pages of a fairytale**. Wander through these charming streets and **past the Cathédrale de Notre Dame** with its famous **astronomical clock**. Alternatively, the **active adventurer** can take a **guided bike ride through this captivating city and Parc de l'Orangerie**. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Tue, June 21 – LUDWIGSHAFEN, GERMANY – RÜDESHEIM. You have a **choice of several excursions**, depending on your interest. Visit **Heidelberg**, a perfectly **preserved medieval city** nestled in the Neckar River Valley along Germany's Castle Road. Alternatively, **relive a bygone era** on a tour of the glorious **Schwetzingen Baroque Palace**. Or, you may decide to **visit Schwetzingen Palace Gardens** with more than 100 sculptures and an assortment of whimsical buildings. The Apollontempel houses a statue of the ancient Greek god of light and the arts, playing the lyre; and the most spectacular, the Türkischer Garten with a mosque, are a few of the many highlights you will see. For a **more active adventure** while in Heidelberg, **join a guided hike up the Philosopher's Path**, aptly named during the Romantic Period, and be rewarded with panoramic views of the city. Later in the day, **sail to Rudesheim** where you can **visit Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum** or **taste one of the town's special delights, Rüdshheimer coffee**, ceremoniously made with brandy. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Wed, June 22 – RÜDESHEIM – RHINE GORGE. Your exploration of Rudesheim continues with your **choice of three excursions**. Take a **gondola ride to the Niederwalddenkmal Statue**. Afterwards, **indulge your taste buds with a sampling of Riesling wines in the vineyards**. Alternatively, you can

join a **guided bike ride through the town and along the Rhine River to Schloss Johannisberg** or **hike through the town's beautiful vineyards**. During the afternoon, set **sail along the scenic Rhine River Gorge** with its fabled legends and many castles. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Thur, June 23 – BERNKASTEL. Sail to Bernkastel, located in the middle of the Moselle Valley's wine-producing region. **Walk through its colorful Old Town** center and past many medieval and Renaissance buildings on a guided tour, and afterwards, be treated to a **wine tasting**. **Cycling enthusiasts can choose to join a bike tour** along the shores of the Moselle River, and **hikers can opt to trek up to the ruins of Landshut Castle**. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Fri, June 24 – TRIER. Enjoy a **scenic morning cruise along the Moselle River** to Trier, Germany's oldest city, where you can discover on a city tour why it has been **called the "Rome of the North" or "Second Rome"** as it has impressive Roman relics and nine UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Alternatively, go in search of the **secrets of the Porta Nigra Gate** on a **tour that takes you back to a time** when Rome ruled the world from the Emperor's seat in Trier. You also have the **choice of a bike tour through the historic city center and along the Moselle River**; or **hike high above Trier to Petrisberg**. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sat, June 25 – COCHEM. Discover how the castle has been an integral part of the town's history, and afterwards, go on a **walking tour along Cochem's narrow cobblestone streets** lined with medieval houses. For a more **active excursion**, **hike to the castle** or go on a **biking tour along the Moselle River**. As an alternative excursion, you can visit **one of Europe's oldest working mustard mills** where you will **sample Cochem's famous mustard**. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Sun, June 26 – COLOGNE. Join a **guided tour** through the **Old Town** and explore the UNESCO-designated **cathedral**. Continue on to the Cologne **Rathaus, Germany's oldest town hall**, and take in other local sights. For a different view of the city, visit a local tavern to taste its **famous Kölsch beer**, only made in Cologne, and **reibekuchen mit apfelmus, potato pancakes typically served with applesauce**. **Active adventurers** will want to join a **guided bike ride along the Rhine**. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Mon, June 27 – AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS. View Amsterdam on a **scenic canal cruise** followed by a **walk to Begijnhof**, known for its Middle Age buildings. Alternately, opt for a rare experience with a journey into the **Netherlands Floriade Expo** in Almere – very close to Amsterdam – which **will feature stunning gardens, innovative sustainable gardening exhibits, live entertainment, souvenirs, and food stalls**. Or taste the local flavor on a **guided walk past the city's iconic canals, gabled houses, narrow bridges and house boats, tasting Dutch specialties at a grand Amsterdam café**. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Tue, June 28 – AMSTERDAM – DISEMBARK AMAPRIMA – HONOLULU. **Disembark the ship**. Bid Farewell to Amsterdam as you prepare for your homeward flight. Depart Amsterdam. Arrive Honolulu the same day. Aloha and Welcome Home. (B)
