2022 WILDLIFE & FRONTIERS: ALASKA CRUISE DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Sightseeing in each port is NOT included. Shore excursions are available for purchase through Oceania Cruises.

Day 1: Sun, June 26 – HONOLULU – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON. Depart Honolulu and arrive Seattle. Transfer to the airport hotel. SEATTLE AIRPORT HOTEL (1 Night)

Day 2: Mon, June 27 – SEATTLE – EMBARK REGATTA. Transfer to pier and embark Regatta. Depart 6:00 pm. (D)

Day 3: Tue, June 28 – CRUISING THE OUTSIDE PASSAGE. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Wed, June 29 – KETCHIKAN, ALASKA Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Totem poles are one of Ketchikan's chief attractions, and the best places to view them are Saxman Village and Totem Bight State Park. Drop by the Southeast Alaska Discovery Center to learn about the local cultures and ecosystems. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Thur, June 30 – JUNEAU, ALASKA. Arrive 12:00 pm. Depart 11:00 pm. For a state capital, Juneau maintains a surprising small-town charm, in part because it can only be reached by sea or air due to the surrounding wilderness. Collections from the indigenous people are displayed in the Alaska State Museum. Visit Mendenhall Glacier for outdoor adventure. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Fri, July 01 – SKAGWAY, ALASKA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Skagway's spectacular natural setting encourages a walking tour of this well-preserved gold rush town. See the Moore House, built in 1897, a year before the gold rush, and the Gold Rush Cemetery, where famed Old West desperado Soapy Smith is buried. Visit the Trail of '98 Museum for a more in-depth look at Skagway's freewheeling history. Or take a ride on the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad and see the trail the gold rushers etched into the high mountain pass. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sat, July 02 – CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Sun, July 03 – ICY STRAIT POINT (HOONAH), ALASKA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Hoonah means "where the north wind doesn't blow" in the language of the Tlingit Indians, who make up about 70% of the population of this village on the lee side of Chichagof Island. However, wildlife outnumbers everyone, so watch for bears, eagles and humpback whales, which migrate here in the summer. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Mon, July 04 – SITKA, ALASKA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Called "Shee Atika" by the Tlingit Indians, then "New Archangel" by the Russians who ousted them, Sitka boasts a multicultural heritage. Two dozen of its attractions are on the National Register of Historic Places, including Castle Hill and Building 29, a structure built by the Russians in 1835. The Sheldon Jackson Museum exhibits one of Alaska's oldest native culture collections. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Tue, July 05 – PRINCE RUPERT, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. British Columbia's most northern coastal city, Prince Rupert sits on the very edge of the wilderness. The majority of its attractions revolve around the outdoors, such as sport fishing or a walking tour of the bonsai-like forest at Oliver Lake. Wildlife abounds, including bears, mountain goats and a variety of migrating whales. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Wed, July 06 – CRUISING THE INSIDE PASSAGE. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Thur, July 07 – VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 11:00 pm. Western Canada's oldest city, Victoria proudly displays its British heritage. Explore lavish Craigdarroch Castle, built in the late 1800s for a Scottish coal baron. Trace the area's early British seafarers in the Marine Museum of British Columbia. There's even a Royal London Wax Museum with likenesses of King Henry VIII and Winston Churchill. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Fri, July 08 – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON – DISEMBARK REGATTA – HONOLULU. Arrive 8:00 am. Disembark Regatta. Depart Seattle pier for half-day sightseeing tour of Seattle. Return flight to Honolulu. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B)
