Day 1: Tue, Oct 05 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Oct 06 – NEW YORK CITY. Arrive New York City. Welcome to New York City! Transfer by coach to the hotel in New York City. The day is at your leisure – start **exploring the city on your own**. Your hotel rooms will not be available until the afternoon. At 6:00 pm, **meet your Tour Director and traveling companions for a welcome drink**. SHERATON NEW YORK TIMES SQUARE HOTEL or similar (1 Night)

Day 3: Thu, Oct 07 – NEW YORK CITY – PHILADELPHIA – WASHINGTON D.C. This morning on the **included orientation tour** with a Local Guide, visit **Broadway**, the **Empire State Building**, **Greenwich Village**, **Chinatown**, and **City Hall**. Later, head to Philadelphia for an **orientation tour** focusing on the important buildings of this historic city, the “Birthplace of the Nation.” During your **free time**, you may want to visit the Liberty Bell, the National Constitution Center, or enjoy lunch and shopping at the Bourse Market. Later, continue south to Washington D.C., the nation’s capital. CAPITAL HILTON or similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 4: Fri, Oct 08 – WASHINGTON D.C. This morning’s sightseeing features many of Washington D.C.’s famous landmarks, including the **VIETNAM and KOREAN WAR VETERANS** and **LINCOLN MEMORIALS**. Also, stop for photos at the **White House and Capitol Hill**. Enjoy an **afternoon at leisure** or visit (on your own) the many museums of the **Smithsonian Institution**. Join us for an optional dinner tonight at one of Washington’s favorite restaurants, followed by an **illumination tour** of some of the city’s most beautiful monuments. (B)

Day 5: Sat, Oct 09 – WASHINGTON D.C. – LANCASTER. Today we journey further through Pennsylvania to Lancaster, home to **Amish and Mennonite communities** whose religious faiths stress humility, family, community, and simple living. Tonight, **visit an AMISH FAMILY** and their **farm**, where you will learn more about their faith, culture, and traditional way of life that excludes the use of modern conveniences, such as electricity and telephones. You’ll have the chance to **visit the barn**, see their **miniature horses**, **learn about their homemade quilts and crafts**, and enjoy a **delicious dinner**. CORK FACTORY HOTEL or similar (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Sun, Oct 10 – LANCASTER – NIAGARA FALLS. Today travel north through the rolling **Appalachian Mountains** and enter New York State. **Cross the border into Canada** for magnificent **Niagara Falls**. Enjoy an evening at leisure. DOUBLETREE FALLSVIEW RESORT & SPA BY HILTON or similar (1 Night) (B)

Day 7: Mon, Oct 11 – NIAGARA FALLS – TORONTO. This morning, **board a Niagara Falls sightseeing CRUISE** for a thrilling boat ride to view the thundering falls from river level. Later, **drive around the “Golden Horseshoe” of Lake Ontario** and through vineyards and rich farmlands to Toronto, the cosmopolitan provincial capital. Then enjoy sightseeing with a Local Guide, view Toronto’s **two city halls**, the **Ontario legislature buildings**, the **university**, and **local neighborhoods**, including **Chinatown**. Tonight, enjoy evening at leisure or **join an optional dinner** outing which includes a visit to the top of the famous **CN Tower** for great views of Toronto’s harbor and skyline. WESTIN HARBOUR CASTLE TORONTO or similar (1 Night) (B)

NOTE: Operation of the Niagara Falls sightseeing cruise is subject to favorable weather and/or river conditions. Favorable conditions usually exist from May to October. When conditions are unfavorable, a walking tour through the scenic tunnels will be substituted.

Day 8: Tue, Oct 12 – TORONTO – OTTAWA. Drive east to Canada’s beautiful capital, **Ottawa**. Located on the banks of the Ottawa River, Ottawa offers a unique blend of culture, history, and outdoor beauty. Tonight, enjoy evening at leisure or why not enjoy one of Ottawa’s many special restaurants. LORD ELGIN HOTEL or similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 9: Wed, Oct 13 – OTTAWA. This morning, enjoy a **tour with a Local Guide** to see Ottawa in-depth. You’ll see the **Canadian Mint**, **residences of the Governor General and Prime Minister**, the **hexagonal National Arts Centre**, **Parliament Hill**, and the **Rideau Canal**. Remainder of the day is free at leisure. (B)

Day 10: Thu, Oct 14 – OTTAWA – MONTRÉAL. Travel to Montréal, Canada’s second-largest city. Then enjoy **sightseeing with a Local Guide** which includes **NOTRE DAME BASILICA**, the **Old Seminary of St. Sulpice**, and a **drive to the top of Mount Royal** to enjoy a panoramic



view of the city. This afternoon and evening is at leisure, perhaps stroll through the underground shopping area of Place Ville-Marie or visit historic Old Montréal. DELTA MONTREAL HOTEL or similar (1 Night) (B)

Day 11: Fri, Oct 15 – MONTRÉAL – QUÉBEC CITY. Travel to east to Québec City and spend the next two nights in this romantic city located on the banks of the mighty St. Lawrence River. Until the British victory of 1759, **Old Québec** was the center of New France, and today is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This afternoon and evening is at leisure, why not enjoy regional French cuisine with dinner in Old Town Québec? DELTA QUEBEC or similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 12: Sat, Oct 16 – QUÉBEC CITY. Join your Local Guide this morning for an **included tour of Québec City**, Canada’s only walled city, including the **Place d’Armes**, ancient **Place Royale**, and the **Plains of Abraham**. The balance of the day is free for independent sightseeing. Tonight’s **included dinner** outing takes you to **MONTMORENCY FALLS** and over **ÎLE D’ORLÉANS** for a delightful dinner at a fine restaurant in a restored 17th century flour mill. (B, D)

Day 13: Sun, Oct 17 – QUÉBEC CITY – FRANCONIA NOTCH STATE PARK – BOSTON. Journey south and capture inspiring views of one of nature’s true masterpieces as the green carpet panorama blends to the grandeur of mountain scenery in **northern Vermont**, which is blessed with innumerable forests and lakes. Then, through New Hampshire to the majestic beauty of **FRANCONIA NOTCH STATE PARK** in the scenic **White Mountains**. Next, pass New Hampshire’s state capitol dome at Concord and continue to Boston. This evening is at leisure. SHERATON BOSTON HOTEL or similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 14: Mon, Oct 18 – BOSTON. This morning, a sightseeing tour focuses on the city’s most prominent landmarks of the Freedom Trail. See **Boston Common**, the **Old State House** and the **Old North Church**, and **Faneuil Hall**. Next, board a **harbor CRUISE** that takes you to see the **Bunker Hill Monument**. Later, enjoy a Boston favorite, an authentic Italian **handmade CANNOLI**. Balance of the day is at your leisure. Tonight, **join your Tour Director for a farewell dinner** at a local restaurant in the famed North End neighborhood. (B, D)

Day 15: Tue, Oct 19 – BOSTON – NEW YORK CITY. This morning, travel to **New York City** and enjoy a free evening to explore the vibrant city. SHERATON NEW YORK TIMES SQUARE HOTEL or similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 16: Wed, Oct 20 – NEW YORK CITY. Your New York extension includes a **scenic narrated skyline harbor CRUISE** to see the city’s famous landmarks. During your free time, why not take advantage of our **optional activities** – visit **Top of the Rock** for sweeping views of Manhattan or enjoy a Broadway show.
