Day 2: Tue, Feb 28 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Wed, Mar 01 – SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE. Arrive in Singapore. Welcome to Singapore! Upon arrival, meet your local guide at the airport and transfer to the hotel for immediate check-in. After breakfast, start the day of touring in the late morning, visiting **Merlion Park**, **Old Parliament House** (outside), **Statues of Sir Stamford Raffles**, and the **Esplanade** (outside). After lunch, visit **Sentosa Island** and **S.E.A. Aquarium**. Enjoy dinner before returning to the hotel for the evening. DORSETT SINGAPORE or Similar (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 4: Thur, Mar 02 – SINGAPORE. Start the day with a visit to the **Singapore Zoo**. After lunch, tour **Little India**, **Sultan Mosque**, **Arab Street**, and **China Town Thian Hock Keng Temple**. For dinner, explore a local **Hawker's Market** and have a *Crazy Rich Asians* experience of your own. (B, L)

Day 5: Fri, Mar 03 – SINGAPORE – EMBARK DIAMOND PRINCESS. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the pier for embarkation on the Diamond Princess. (B, D)

Day 6: Sat, Mar 04 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sun, Mar 05 – HO CHI MINH CITY (PHŨ MỸ), VIETNAM. 7:00 am – 6:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Wed, Mar 15 – YOKOHAMA – DISEMBARK DIAMOND PRINCESS – KAMAKURA – TOKYO. After disembarkation, meet our local guide and start our day of touring at the nearby **Sankeien Garden** – a spacious Japanese-style garden in southern Yokohama which exhibits a number of historic buildings from across Japan. There is a pond, small rivers, flowers and wonderful strolling trails that make you think you are in Kyoto rather than Yokohama. Then depart Yokohama for

Kamakura. Visit **Tsurugaoka Hachimangu** which is dedicated to Hachiman, the patron god of the Minamoto family and of the samurai in general. Enjoy some free time for fun, shopping, and eating (on your own) at **Komachi Dori Shopping Street**, a 360 meter long shopping street full of restaurants and stores. After lunch, explore the grounds of **Kotokuin Temple** and the **Kamakura Daibutsu** (The Great Buddha of Kamakura). A bronze statue of Amida Buddha, the statue reaches a height of 11.4 meters and has long been the second tallest bronze Buddha statue in Japan, surpassed only by the statue in Nara's Todaiji Temple and some recent creations. Finally, visit the **Hase Temple**, a temple of the Jodo sect, famous for its eleven-headed statue of Kannon, the goddess of mercy. The 9.18 meter tall wooden statue is regarded as one of the largest wooden sculptures in Japan. Transfer to the hotel for the evening. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. The local guide will have suggestions on various dining and shopping opportunities nearby. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO (2 Nights) (B)

Day 18: Thur, Mar 16 – TOKYO. Day at Leisure. Enjoy shopping and dining in the bustling Shinjuku area. Your local guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Tokyo. (B)

Day 19: Fri, Mar 17 – TOKYO – HONOLULU. Start the day with a visit to the visually stimulating **Harajuku Shopping District**. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **Sushi Making Session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. After lunch, visit Ameyoko, a busy market street along the Yamanote Line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "Ameya Yokocho" (candy store alley), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "Ame" also stands for "America," because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following World War II. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Then, you'll have the opportunity to experience a **traditional Japanese Tea Ceremony**. Next, take a tour of the **Edo-Tokyo Museum**, which vividly illustrates the past of Tokyo (known as Edo until 1869) through its exhibits. Visitors are able to experience and learn about various aspects of what life was like during the Edo period. Lastly, visit **Tokyo SkyTree** for a view of the surrounding city. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo SkyTree Tembo Deck offers a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Depart Tokyo and arrive Honolulu the same day. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B, L)
